When & Where

Training is delivered over four 1½ hour sessions (1 per week) at The Tyrells Centre, Thundersley by volunteer tutors. Each class has a maximum of 10 learners.

Topics Covered

At the beginning of each course tutors will ask learners what they would like achieve and sessions are taken at each individual's pace. We cover the basics from turning on and controlling the mouse to sending emails and accessing internet to creating, printing & saving documents.
